The deferment, suspension or cancelation will not take effect until the internal appeals process is completed, unless the overseas student's health or well-being, or the well-being of others, is likely to be at risk.

Please note: It is advised that students should have a valid deferment or suspension, because abandoning your studies might lead to cancellation of your visa and you may not be allowed to enter into Australia.
